



Printing from ResNet

Printing from ResNet requires Windows and Internet Explorer. It does not work on a Mac or with Firefox or Safari.

Steps to follow

- 1) Connect to ResNet and then established a VPN connection with Cisco AnyConnect Client
- 2) Open Internet Explorer and go to <http://mars/printers>
- 3) Log in using your email address and password (figure 1)
- 4) Click on 'Next 10 Printers ' until you see the printer you want to use and then click on it (figure 2)
e.g LI Computer Lab Upstairs (BW)
- 5) Once you've clicked on the printer, click on 'Connect' (figure 3) and the printer will install on your computer.
- 6) You can now use the installed printer to print your documents
