CARROLL COLLEGE IS A CATHOLIC, DIOCESAN, LIBERAL ARTS COLLEGE in the ecumenical tradition of the Second Vatican Council. As a liberal arts school, Carroll College acknowledges the practical role of preparing its students for a career, but it also affirms the traditional role of providing for the expansion of the intellectual, imaginative, and social awareness of its students. It is dedicated to providing for its students the means for their full realization of a dual goal of vocation and enlightenment. Thus, while providing substantial professional and pre-professional programs, the College encourages and expects all students to participate in a broad spectrum of academic disciplines.

As an academic community, Carroll College affirms its commitment to the principle of freedom of inquiry in the process of investigating, understanding, critically reflecting upon, and finally judging reality and truth in all fields of human knowledge. As value-oriented, Carroll College is committed to and deeply involved in the further dimension of free deliberation and decision making regarding values and personal commitment. Each student at Carroll, through personal and institutional means, is exposed to value systems with which one can readily identify, including secular values such as the worth of work and the use of the intellect, humanistic values centering on the uniqueness and dignity of the person, and religious and moral values concerned with one's relationship to God, self, and others.

As a Catholic college, Carroll is obligated to treat judgments concerning ultimate reality and decisions concerning ultimate value at both an academic and a pastoral level. This obligation involves the College's relationship to the Magisterium of the Catholic Church, defined as "the perennial, authentic, and infallible teaching office committed to the Apostles by Christ and now possessed and exercised by their legitimate successors, the college of bishops in union with the pope." Carroll College is committed to present faithfully within its curriculum the magisterial teachings of the Catholic Church. At the same time, it acknowledges the special role of the theologian, who—although not a part of the authoritative teaching body of the Church—makes available to the Magisterium his or her scientific competence, while acting as a mediator between religion and culture by carrying on an academic dialogue with philosophy, science, the liberal arts, the believing community, and secular society.

As a college founded by and related to the Diocese of Helena, Carroll has a special obligation to provide for the spiritual needs of the college community. At the same time, the resources of the College's Theology Department, and campus ministry organization are available for the special religious needs of the diocesan community as a whole. Moreover, Carroll College rededicates its spiritual, academic, and social resources to the service of the citizens of Montana, its home, and to the worldwide human family through continuing efforts to guarantee to individuals, to groups, and especially to minorities the right to life, to personal and social dignity, and to equality of opportunity in all aspects of human activity.

In the ecumenical tradition of the Second Vatican Council, Carroll College is committed to a policy of open participation by members of all religious faiths and all persons of good will in the total academic and spiritual experience of the college community. While standing fast by the teaching of the Catholic Church, and avoiding a false conciliatory approach foreign to the true spirit of ecumenism, Carroll College welcomes in love and respect the full participation of other Christians and non-Christians in an ecumenical dialogue and in a truly humble and charitable joint venture in the common search for the Ultimate Truth and the Ultimate Good which is the final goal of all education.

More than a look backward, this annual report is also a means to gaze forward, mindfully discussing our future in fresh new ways. These include improving campus resources, creating new degree programming and providing additional opportunities across the globe.

An eagerly anticipated and much needed imperative we plan to address in the near-term is enhancing campus life by providing additional housing options, with the first new building open for our residential students by fall 2014. Developing graduate and interdisciplinary degree programs at Carroll is another opportunity for the college. At this point in our history, we are perfectly poised to inaugurate bold

new graduate studies programs in academic areas of the most interest to today's students. Carroll is also well positioned to combine its excellence in relevant areas for interdisciplinary and integrated studies across the liberal arts and professions. Providing both types of programming will allow Carroll students to be even better prepared to enter the workplace or give them the option to stay, return or come to the campus for the first time to pursue a graduate degree.

Another example is our revitalized commitment to global education. Since my arrival, Carroll has created formal partnerships in Chile, France and Spain, with pending agreements in Japan and Korea. We endeavor to deepen these relationships to enhance the learning they offer our students.

Carroll already has a firm tradition of translating academics to international service through our Engineers Without Borders chapter, the Carroll Outreach Team and Campus Ministry. However, there is much more we are eager to accomplish to surpass these accomplishments.

While many colleges simply provide lists of available study abroad opportunities, Carroll's view is much more expansive, focused on our mission. We want to create sustainable programs on three more continents, with all education abroad experiences reinforcing each student's connection to a global vision that expands on their particular areas of study and professional career ambitions.

The future of Carroll depends on all manner of growing. It relies especially on boosting our enrollment and our competitive ability to draw and retain the most outstanding students of character from Montana, throughout the US and around the globe. We can accomplish this through continued emphasis on our proven strengths while bravely advancing into new ventures that complement our traditions.

People sometimes ask why Carroll should grow, add programs or facilities, when these undertakings can be expensive and resource consumptive. To this, I can echo the philosophy of Walt Disney, who said "I don't make pictures just to make money. I make money to



make more pictures." At Carroll, we don't simply build and grow just so we can grab a few headlines and boast that we're getting bigger. We must take Bishop Carroll's founding vision to its extreme because, at our cores, we in the Carroll family believe that the world is a better place because there are more of our graduates working and serving humanity's highest purposes.

FAITH FLOWERING ON CAMPUS

Momentum for a new chapel on campus began in earnest just over six months ago, when Dr. James and Joan Schneller donated their 30-acre farm in Spanaway, Wash., just outside Tacoma. With their gift, they directed that the proceeds from the sale be used to fund the Carroll chapel project.

This gift of property builds on a previous donation from the Schnellers, which provided funds for architectural renderings and preliminary project support. Born out of a long-cherished vision of the Schnellers and with growing support to make it a reality, this beautiful dream will be a permanent joy to behold at Carroll in the years ahead.





UPON THIS ROCK I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH

Shortly before the holidays, Dr. Earl Heller, a Carroll class of 1958 graduate and longtime South Bend, Ind., orthopedic surgeon, sent his alma mater a very special Christmas gift: \$1 million, one of the largest donations in the college's history.

"Dr. Heller calls this a Christmas gift for Carroll," says Carroll President Tom Evans, PhD, "but the legacy of this generosity will endure in perpetuity."

Dr. Heller made the donation with the direction that it be used to begin the process of establishing a new chapel at Carroll College. The chapel project, envisioned in Carroll's centennial-year master plan, would be a center of the Catholic college's faith life and home for religious services to accommodate the increasing numbers of faithful attending Masses on campus almost every day of the week.

"Dr. Heller is a great friend of Carroll and is deeply committed to our Catholic heritage and identity. He has been interested for many years in providing Carroll a lasting gift to enhance our Catholic tradition, and he found this Christmas season the inspiration," Evans says.

Born and raised in Helena, Dr. Heller attended Cathedral High School and after graduating from Carroll earned his medical degree at the University of Kansas. After his orthopedic surgery residency, he practiced orthopedic surgery in South Bend from 1971 to 2012.

"No amount of money can compensate Carroll College for all of the benefits bestowed on me as a result of attending Carroll. However, I

am making this donation with the intention of honoring those who have worked so hard to make Carroll such a great place of learning," Dr. Heller says. Drawing on the history of Carroll's founding by Bishop of Helena John Patrick Carroll in 1909, Dr. Heller notes the concurrent Cathedral of St. Helena and Carroll College construction projects were made possible through the generosity of patrons like mining magnate Thomas Cruse, railroad mogul Peter Larson and Montana US Senator T.C. Power. Bishop Carroll's vision of a Catholic college drove him to use some of the early large donations for the cathedral to establish Carroll, which was originally called Mount St. Charles College.

"We are conscious of our debt of gratitude to these founders of Carroll, and their memory must be preserved," Dr. Heller adds. "I'm honored to share and support President Tom Evans' vision for the future of Carroll College. With his leadership and the support of Bishop of Helena George Leo Thomas and Carroll's chaplain, Fr. Marc Lenneman, as well as a strong board of trustees and a great faculty, that vision for Carroll will rival that of Bishop John Patrick Carroll, the college's founder."

Dr. Heller also intends his gift to honor his parents. "Although they had very limited eco-

nomical resources, they instilled a strong sense of love and pride in their children," Dr. Heller recalls. "A lot of their life centered on the St. Helena Cathedral. They also provided me the opportunity to become fiercely independent, very competitive, industrious and compassionate—traits that served me well in my career. I'm also deeply indebted to my grandmother, Dora Heller, who promised my mother on the day of my birth that she would say a prayer to St. Anthony every day of her life that I would make something of myself. I'm thankful she lived to be 95 years old and was able to witness my goal of becoming a physician. As you can well imagine, St. Anthony has been my adopted patron saint."

The Heller gift is the seed from which a future chapel will take root. While estimates for construction vary, depending on where the project would be planned, such a campus addition would be a multi-million dollar effort. The new faith home for Carroll is founded on the faith that others will join with Dr. Heller in bringing the dream home to campus.

"I'm hopeful my gift will encourage others to become donors and that a new chapel will serve as a memorial to those who have dedicated their life to Carroll," Dr. Heller says.

THE ANNUAL REPORT is one small way that Carroll College can properly recognize and thank the college's alumni and friends who support our mission.

We are grateful beyond words for the expression of confidence in our educational quality and the day-to-day endeavors of our students and all the Carroll employees who support them, teach them and send them off to success. We hear from alumni constantly, telling us that the impact of Carroll College on the lives of students is profound and lasts forever. This impact is the result of a strong sense of responsibility and delicate care from our faculty and staff who are committed to the Carroll student. Your support for the people of Carroll and their unwavering commitment to the gold standard in higher education reflects your values. Your values—the value that you place on Carroll College—as reflected in this annual report reveals one truth: our future is bright.

During the past four calendar years, we have noticed an increase each year in the number of gifts received. In 2008, we received 4,798 gifts, and in 2011 there were 5,751. This is an important trend for more than the obvious reasons. Foundations that provide major donations to colleges and universities are looking for proof that institutions have the support of their alumni, their employees and their Boards of Trustees. These foundations are more willing to support colleges that can provide data to demonstrate that their alumni

and friends care about the institution. Last year, 76% of our employees gave to Carroll, 100% of our Board, and 14% of our 10,698 alumni.

We have experienced a brief down-turn in alumni participation over the past few years, as have most other colleges, due to the recession. However, while the number of Carroll alumni donors has decreased over the last five years, revenue from alumni giving during that same time has increased 24%. Carroll alumni donors loyally gave multi-year gifts for a retention rate of 69%, putting Carroll among the top of comparable schools for donor loyalty. This makes Carroll highly competitive in the criteria weighed by foundations and is also figured into national rankings of the best colleges, where Carroll also excels.

In addition to how Carroll provides such life-changing experiences, what we hear most often from our alumni and friends are comments about the beauty of our expanding campus and the quality of our students. We have much to be proud of, and we are drawing on this source of pride to provide new facilities to attract and keep the very best scholars at Carroll. We have much to be thankful for and will be giving thanks anew this coming year with announcements of new historic milestones. Yet, we are ever mindful that the chief inspirations for our thanksgiving are always our vigilant, loyal and loving alumni and friends who keep Carroll vibrant and growing through the ages.
