DESCRIPTION

Any new freshman, enrolling fall 2021, is encouraged to apply. Students must declare as majors in Catholic Studies during the first year at Carroll College. A short application and student statement are required. The statement should express why you are interested in Catholic Studies and how the major will help you to achieve your intellectual and other goals. Value of the scholarship is \$1,000 for the year per student. Two scholarships will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Enrolled fall 2021.
2. New freshman.
3. Declare major in Catholic Studies during the first year.
4. Attending full-time (12 credits or more).
5. Complete application.
6. Complete student statement.

SELECTION COMMITTEE AND NOTIFICATION OF AWARDS

The Catholic Studies program will review applications and select scholarship recipients. Carroll's Financial Aid Office will notify applicants of the results of the selection process.

2. Submit the completed application to the Financial Aid Office (ATTN: Financial Aid Director) by March 1, 2021.
3. Financial Aid Director provides committee members with the applications.
