

## 2021-2022 Patrick J. Kelly Scholarship

The Patrick J. Kelly Scholarship is named in honor of the lawyer from Miles City Montana, who carried on a legacy of law practice dating back to 1916. The scholarship is awarded to a high school senior who exemplifies the quality, character, and academic promise of students enrolled at Carroll College.

The Mary K. and Daniel M. Kelly Foundation will award one student a scholarship of up to \$10,000 for the 2021-2022 academic year (\$5,000 a semester).

The scholarship will not exceed cost of attendance when combined with other awards. The award will be in addition to other Carroll College scholarships and grants. Renewal is based on potential funding available the following year and maintaining satisfactory academic progress as outlined by school policy as well as progressing timely toward a four-year graduation completion. Criteria will be ability to succeed.

## Patrick J. Kelly Scholarship for Eastern Montana Students

- Incoming freshman that is a high school graduate of Custer County High School in Miles City, Montana
  - Should an eligible student not be identified from Custer County High School, consideration may be given to students graduating from high schools in the following eastern Montana counties:
    - Custer, Big Horn, Powder River, Carter, Fallon, Rosebud, Treasure, Garfield, Prairie, Wibaux, Dawson, and McCone
- Full-time student
- 3.0 minimum cumulative high school GPA; potential renewal cumulative GPA of 2.5 required
  - o Preference as determined by GPA, class rank, and/or standardized test scores
- Application due by March 15, 2021
- Deposit deadline of May 1, 2021
- Preference given to American Indian students
- 2021 FAFSA results are required by March 15, 2021 to establish need (scholarship is need-based).
  - $\circ$  Preference will be given to those with an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of less than  $\$10,\!000$
